



How to create direct hyperlinks to specific language pairs (with or without a specific learning language)

Overview

This document explains how to place hyperlinks on your website so that patrons can access specific language pairs in Pronunciator (without the need for them to navigate through the “I speak” and “I want to learn” dropdown menus in Pronunciator).

Background

The normal URL of the Pronunciator app is:

<https://www.pronunciator.com/app>

With the direct link method, however, you can specify the interface language and learning language, so that users can gain access to your chosen language pair directly. If they are already logged in, they will be taken directly there; if they are not logged in, they will be taken directly there after logging in.

You can also specify an *interface* language alone, and have the user choose a *learning* language from a list of languages presented in the specified interface language.

An “interface language” is the language in which a user learns their target learning language. For example, for most native English speakers in the US, US English will be their interface language. A full list of interface languages, with their unique identifiers, is provided on subsequent pages in this document.

A “learning language” is the language the user wants to learn. A full list of learning languages, with their unique identifiers, is provided on subsequent pages in this document.

Important note: the interface language id’s don’t always correspond to the learning language id’s, so you need to be aware of that when constructing your URL. For example, the US English *learning* language id is “1” but its *interface* id is “297”.

Implementation of Direct Link with *both* Interface and Learning Languages Specified

This is the template for linking to a specific learning language with a specific interface language:

https://www.pronunciator.com/app/#/direct/I_LANG/L_LANG

The above link opens the course list for the French learning language using the US English interface language.

Implementation of Direct Link with *only* Interface Languages Specified

This is the template for linking to a specific interface language (after which the user must select a learning language from a list):

https://www.pronunciator.com/app/#/direct/I_LANG
